Addendum

The following communication, dated 6 October 2016, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of Argentina.

Motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers

Please be advised that Article 10 of Resolution No. 323/2014 of the former Secretariat of Industry (notified in document G/TBT/N/ARG/289) has been replaced by the following text pursuant to Secretariat of Industry and Services Resolution No. 314/E-2016:

"ARTICLE 10 - Conformity certificates issued prior to the entry into force of this Resolution, which may be renewed for a period of five years using the procedure stipulated in the preceding Article, shall expire according to the following schedule:

(a) Certificates issued up until 31 March 2012 shall expire on 31 March 2017.

(b) Certificates issued as from 1 April 2012 shall expire five years from their date of issuance.

Applications to renew conformity certificates must be submitted to the National Institute of Industrial Technology (INTI), an autonomous body within the Ministry of Production, no less than 120 days before their expiry date. Applications submitted after the aforementioned deadline will be processed in accordance with the procedure established for the issuance of a new conformity certificate pursuant to Decree No. 779 of 20 November 1995 and Resolution No. 838 of 11 November 1999 of the former Secretariat of Industry, Trade and Mining of the former Ministry of Economy and Public Works and Services."
