- 4. Products covered (HS or CCCN where applicable, otherwise national tariff heading. ICS numbers may be provided in addition, where applicable): Milk and milk products (ICS: 67.100), Ice cream and ice confectionery (ICS: 67.100.40), Edible oils and fats. Oilseeds (ICS: 67.200)
- 5. Title, number of pages and language(s) of the notified document: Decree laying down the requirements for milk and milk products, ice creams and edible fats and oils (32 pages, in Czech)
- 6. **Description of content:** The main objective of submitting a new decree is to adapt the requirements for milk and milk products, ice creams and edible fats and oils to directly applicable EU legislation relating to, for example, food labelling, hygiene rules or marketing standards, as well as to scientific knowledge and technological developments in the food industry. The need for this draft stems from the experience gained in the application of the existing Decree No 77/2003 laying down the requirements for milk and milk products, ice creams and edible fats and oils, as amended.

The draft adapts this legislation, for example, to Regulation (EU) No 1169/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the provision of food information to consumers, in particular by removing duplicate provisions relating to the labelling of foodstuffs and by modifying terminology, and to Regulation (EC) No 1924/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council on nutrition and health claims made on foods, as amended, in the context of the decree on the labelling of foodstuffs and an amendment to Act No 110/1997 on foodstuffs and tobacco products.

This decree is one of the measures implementing Act No 110/1997 on foodstuffs and tobacco products, as amended, which contains the clause on the mutual recognition of products.

- 7. Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable: The existing legislation was found to be inadequate. Hence, the key objectives of this draft are increased protection of consumers and adaptation to the developments in both European and national food legislation.
