Title, number of pages and language(s) of the notified document: Draft Commission Implementing Regulation amending Implementing Regulation (EU) No 414/2013 specifying a procedure for the authorisation of same biocidal products in accordance with Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council (5 pages, in English)
- 6. **Description of content:** Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No 414/2013 specifies a simplified procedure for granting different authorisations, e.g. to different authorisation holders, of biocidal products which are identical in respect of everything (having the same properties), except some administrative details. The notified draft Commission Implementing Regulation introduces some changes to the authorisation procedure aiming at providing for further simplification and to better respond to the needs of prospective applicants, in particular, of small and medium size enterprises (SMEs).
- 7. Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable: Protection of public health and of the environment. Harmonisation of the EU market on biocidal products.
