The following communication, received on 25 August 2016, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of the United States of America.

TITLE: Energy Conservation Program: Energy Conservation Standards for Dehumidifiers

AGENCY: Office of Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy, Department of Energy

ACTION: Final rule; technical correction

SUMMARY: The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) published a final rule in the Federal Register on 13 June 2016, adopting more-stringent energy conservation standards for dehumidifiers. This correction addresses an error in the final rule by clarifying in Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), section 430.32 the energy efficiency metric used to determine compliance with the amended standards. Neither the error nor the correction in this document affect the substance of the energy conservation standards rulemaking or any of the conclusions reached in support of the final rule. In addition, DOE removed 10 CFR 430.32(v)(1) because the requirement is now obsolete.

This correction is effective 22 August 2016.
