5. Title, number of pages and language(s) of the notified document: Regulations Amending Certain Regulations Made Under Sections 140, 209 and 286.1 of the Canadian Environmental Protection Act, 1999 (28 pages, available in English and French)

Description of content: Environment and Climate Change Canada proposes to amend five Regulations within an omnibus process in order to make required changes to improve the clarity and consistency of the regulatory texts and compliance requirements, and to keep references to standards up to date. Furthermore, the proposed amendments aim to respond to concerns, comments and recommendations from the Standards Council of Canada, the Standing Joint Committee for the Scrutiny of Regulations and the Commissioner of the Environment and Sustainable Development. The five regulations are: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Fuels Information Regulations, No.12. Gasoline Regulations3. Sulphur in Diesel Fuel Regulations4. Storage Tank Systems for Petroleum Products and Allied Petroleum Products Regulations, and5. Regulations Designating Regulatory Provisions for Purposes of Enforcement (Canadian Environmental Protection Act, 1999)
