- 4. Products covered (HS or CCCN where applicable, otherwise national tariff heading. ICS numbers may be provided in addition, where applicable): Thermal paper containing bisphenol A in a concentration equal to or greater than 0.02% by weight
- 5. Title, number of pages and language(s) of the notified document: Draft Commission Regulation amending Annex XVII to Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) as regards bisphenol A (4 pages + Annex 2 pages, in English)
- **6. Description of content:** This draft Regulation relates to a new entry in Annex XVII to Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006.

It would restrict the placing on the market of thermal paper containing bisphenol A in a concentration equal to or greater than 0.02% by weight.

Application of the restriction is deferred for three years to allow industry sufficient time to comply with the obligations described above.

7. Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable: The exposure to bisphenol A from thermal paper receipts causes a risk to workers (cashiers).

The proposed restriction would also protect consumers as it would apply to the placing on the market of thermal papers. No significant burden on industry, the supply chain or consumers is expected. Bisphenol A has already been largely substituted by other substances.
