Description of content: This Draft East African Standard specifies the requirements, methods of sampling and test for wheat flour prepared from common wheat. <i>Triticum aestivum</i> L. or club wheat, <i>Triticum compactum</i> host, or mixtures thereof intended for human consumption. It does not apply to wheat flour obtained from <i>Triticum durum</i> and fortified wheat flour.
