<b>5. Title, number of pages and language(s) of the notified document:</b> The Government Decision no.8 of 20.01.2016 "Concerning the approval of the Technical Regulation on elevators and spare components for elevators", (40 page(s), in Romanian)
<b>6. Description of content:</b> The technical regulation provides requirements for manufacturers, installers, importers, authorized representatives, distributors, conformity assessment bodies, notifying body and market surveillance authority, with a description of the obligations of each participant in the supply chain, as well as the modules for assessing the conformity of elevators and components for lifts.
<b>7. Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable:</b> Creation of the consolidated legal framework, based on clearly defined legal concepts regulating the production of elevators and safety components for them, which are made available on the market or are used. The objective of this act is to ensure a required level of safety of exploded goods and public interests such as the health and safety of people.
<b>8. Relevant documents:</b> Directive 2014/33/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 26 February 2014 on the harmonization of the laws of the Member States relating to lifts and safety components for lifts
<b>9. Proposed date of adoption:</b> 20 January 2016 <b>Proposed date of entry into force:</b> Beginning of 2018
