- **Title, number of pages and language(s) of the notified document:** Draft Commission Directive amending, for the purposes of adaptation to technical and scientific developments, point 13 of part III of Annex II to Directive 2009/48/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council on the safety of toys, as regards aluminium. - **Description of content:** In order to increase children's safety, lower migration limits for aluminium are introduced in the table under point 13 of part III of Annex II to Directive 2009/48/EC.

Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable:** Protection of human health and safety, in particular protection of children's health against exposure to aluminium from toys or components of toys in a) dry, brittle, powder-like or pliable toy material, b) liquid or sticky toy material and c) scraped-off toy material.
