Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable:</b> Considering the growing industrialization, with the consequent increase in atmospheric pollution levels already reached, mainly in metropolitan regions, and the negative effects on health, the environment, the economy and the degradation of air quality, the Ordinance aims to minimize the impacts on air quality and, thus, protect the health and well-being of the population. The Ordinance also considers that determining national atmospheric emission limits must also take into account its costs and impact on regional economies.; Protection of human health or safety; Quality requirements
