JOINT STATEMENT ON ELECTRONIC COMMERCE

COMMUNICATION FROM CÔTE D'IVOIRE

The following communication, dated 15 July 2019, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of Côte D'Ivoire.

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Côte d'Ivoire to the United Nations, the WTO and other International Organizations in Geneva presents its compliments to the Secretariat of the World Trade Organization (WTO) and the Trade Negotiations Committee, and has the honour to inform them that Côte d'Ivoire has decided to join the Joint Initiative on Electronic Commerce Group that was established through the Ministerial Joint Statement on Electronic Commerce (WT/MIN(17)/60) of 13 December 2017. The Group launched its activities on 25 January 2019 at the World Economic Forum in Davos, where it also gained new members.
