<p>This Act revises the law relating to broadcasting services and content. It also establishes the Broadcasting Authority of Ireland; dissolves the Broadcasting Commission of Ireland and the Broadcasting Complaints Commission; amends and repeals certain enactments relating to broadcasting; provides for matters relating to TV licences; provides for the regulation and provision of telecommunications services and provides for connected matters which include an amendment to copyright legislation.</p>
