OUTCOME OF THE TRANSPOSITION EXERCISE (HS2002, HS2007 AND HS2012)¹

Corrigendum

1. On page 5 (English version), sub-heading 03.08 should read as follows:

03.08	Aquatic invertebrates other than crustaceans and molluscs, live, fresh, chilled, frozen, dried, salted or in brine; smoked aquatic invertebrates other than crustaceans and molluscs, whether or not cooked before or during the smoking process; flours, meals and pellets of aquatic invertebrates other than crustaceans and molluscs, fit for human consumption.	As specified for split headings	HS2012 (WCO recommendation)
ex03.08(a)	- Dried	CTHS	
ex03.08(b)	- Flours	CTHS, except from split heading ex03.08(c)	Revised
ex03.08(c)	- Meals and pellets	CTHS except from split heading ex03.08(b)	Revised
ex03.08(d)	- Smoked	CTHS except from heading 16.05	Revised
ex03.08(e)	- Other	The origin shall be the country where the animals have been captured or gathered.	

2. The rule for split heading 03.08(b) should therefore be rectified (by deleting the exception from sub-heading 16.05) and an exception should be added to split heading 03.08(c) ("except from split heading ex03.08(b)").
