Kindly note that:

On page 1, the following lines should be added immediately after the adoption of the agenda:

"The representative of <u>Ukraine</u> said that today was the 15th day that the Russian Federation continued to commit a blatant act of aggression against Ukraine.

The representative of the <u>Russian Federation</u> raised a point of order.

The <u>Chair</u> said that he would allow Ukraine to continue."

On page 2, the second sentence of the statement of the United Kingdom should read:

 \dots The UK and its international partners stood united in condemning the Russian government's reprehensible actions which were an egregious violation of international law and the UN Charter. \dots

On page 3, the fifth sentence of the statement of the European Union should read:

... The European Union resolutely supported Ukraine's inherent right of self-defence and the Ukrainians' efforts to defend Ukraine's territorial integrity and population in accordance with article 51 of the UN Charter. ...

On page 7, paragraph 3.6, the last sentence should read:

"In his humble view, the minutes of the meeting should reflect the statements made at the meeting."
