

## 1. Paragraph 25:

## 4. Agreement on the Application of Sanitary and Phytosanitary Measures (SPS)

25. In 2009, 737 regular notifications<sup>11</sup> were made under the SPS Agreement.<sup>12</sup> In 2009, 11 per cent of all SPS notifications (81 notifications) were environment-related.
