The following communication, dated 15 April 2019, from the delegation of Indonesia to the Chairperson of the Dispute Settlement Body, is circulated pursuant to Article 21.6 of the DSU.

---

Indonesia submits this report in accordance with Article 21.6 of the Understanding on Rules and Procedures Governing the Settlement of Disputes (DSU).

On 22 November 2017, the Dispute Settlement Body (DSB) adopted its recommendations and rulings in *Indonesia – Measures Concerning the Importation of Chicken Meat and Chicken Products (WT/DS484)*. At the DSB meeting on 22 January 2018, Indonesia informed the DSB its intention to implement the recommendations and rulings of the DSB related to this matter.

Indonesia and Brazil also informed the DSB, on 15 March 2018, their agreement for the reasonable period of time for Indonesia to implement the recommendations and rulings of the DSB. This reasonable period of time expired on 22 July 2018.

The Government of Indonesia has undertaken necessary steps to adjust its relevant measures. With regard to undue delay measure, health certificate questionnaire submitted by Brazil will be processed without delay in line with first come first serve basis.

Indonesia stands ready to continue communications, and holding consultations as and when necessary, with Brazil pertaining to the matter above.
