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UNITED STATES – MEASURES ON CERTAIN SEMICONDUCTOR AND OTHER PRODUCTS, AND RELATED SERVICES AND TECHNOLOGIES

COMMUNICATION FROM THE UNITED STATES

The following communication, dated 9 February 2023, was received from the delegation of the United States with the request that it be circulated to the Dispute Settlement Body (DSB).

The United States is in receipt of a letter from the Russian Federation, dated December 21, 2022, requesting to join in the consultations requested by China as circulated in document WT/DS615/1. In light of Russia's premeditated and unprovoked invasion of Ukraine, the United States does not intend to engage in business-as-usual activity with the delegation of the Russian Federation, including direct engagement on this matter. Furthermore, the United States does not consider Russia's claim of substantial interest to be well-founded.

Thus, without prejudice to WTO rules that issues of national security are not susceptible to review or capable of resolution by WTO dispute settlement,¹ the United States does not accept Russia's request to join the consultations.
