STATEMENT BY H.E. MR SOSTEN ALFRED GWENGWE MINISTER OF TRADE AND INDUSTRY

Malawi

We are living in a time when effective collaboration is so paramount to the WTO achieving its mandate of an effective multilateral trading system as enshrined in the Marrakesh Agreement.
