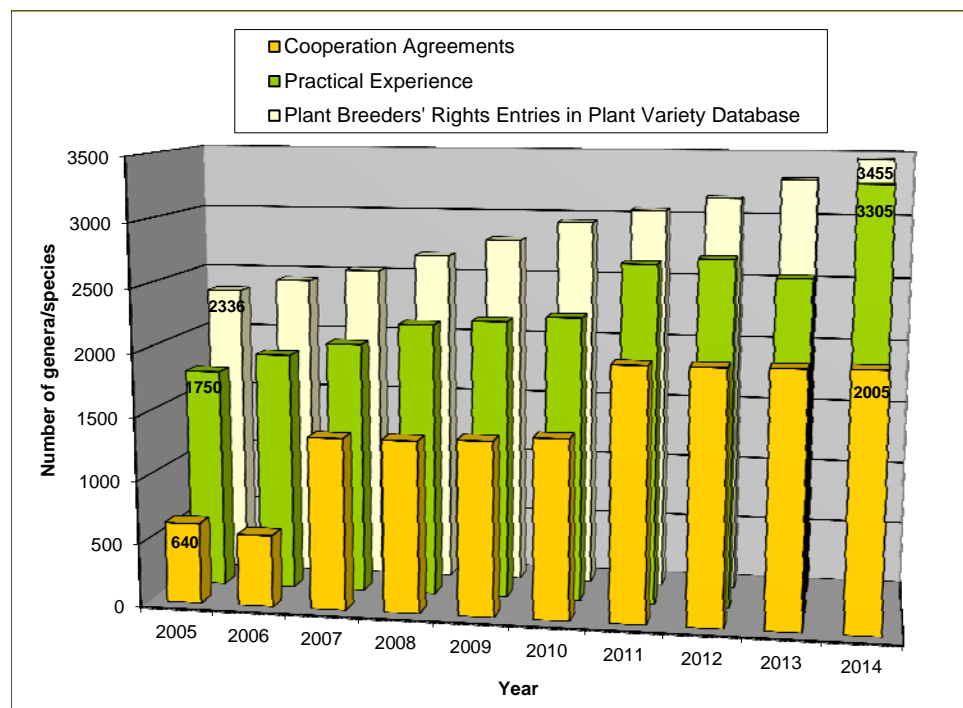
INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION FACILITATED BY UPOV

The purpose of these Test Guidelines is to provide practical guidance for the harmonized examination of DUS and, in particular, to identify appropriate characteristics for the examination of DUS and production of harmonized variety descriptions. In 2013, the adopted Test Guidelines covered 91% of all entries concerning plant variety protection in the PLUTO Plant Variety Database (217,298 of 247,818).
