UPOV has developed "Guidelines for the Conduct of Tests for Distinctness, Uniformity and Stability," or "Test Guidelines", for many individual species or other variety groupings (see https://www.upov.int/test_guidelines/en). The purpose of these Test Guidelines is to provide practical guidance for the harmonized examination of DUS and, in particular, to identify appropriate characteristics for the examination of DUS and production of harmonized variety descriptions. In 2018, the adopted Test Guidelines covered 94% of all entries concerning plant variety protection in the PLUTO Plant Variety Database (299,064 of 319,547).
