G. Observaciones de carácter general, con inclusión de una descripción de la eliminación de restricciones notificada en el apartado 2.2 de la casilla D y la fecha en que esas restricciones dejaron de estar en vigor.

Mediante la presente notificación se comunica el establecimiento, por Australia, de restricciones cuantitativas a las importaciones y exportaciones de mercancías entre Australia y la Federación de Rusia. Estas prohibiciones se aplican en virtud de la Ley de Sanciones Autónomas y del Reglamento de Sanciones Autónomas de Australia, de 2011, y son una respuesta a la invasión ilegal de Ucrania por parte de Rusia. Son necesarias para la protección de los intereses esenciales en materia de seguridad de Australia. Los actos de Rusia constituyen una violación flagrante del derecho internacional, incluida la Carta de las Naciones Unidas. Vulneran la soberanía y la integridad territorial de Ucrania y socavan el orden internacional basado en normas. Australia está determinada a defender esos principios, que son fundamentales para la estabilidad y la seguridad internacionales, regionales y nacionales.
