SUBJECT: MEETING OF COUNCIL OF REPRESENTATIVES, 27 MAY

THE NEXT MEETING OF THE COUNCIL WILL BE HELD AT THE INTERNATIONAL LABOUR OFFICE, GENEVA, ON WEDNESDAY 27 MAY, BEGINNING AT 10 AM.

IT IS PROPOSED THAT THE AGENDA FOR THE MEETING SHOULD INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

1. UNITED STATES TARIFF CLASSIFICATION: REQUEST BY THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE DECISION OF 20 JULY 1963 (L/2219).
2. ARTICLE XV:6: REQUEST BY THE CUBAN GOVERNMENT FOR WAIVER FROM THE OBLIGATION TO ACCEPT A SPECIAL EXCHANGE AGREEMENT (L/2216 AND Add.1).
3. BALANCE-OF-PAYMENTS RESTRICTIONS: REPORTS ON CONSULTATIONS WITH CEYLON, PAKISTAN AND SOUTH AFRICA.
4. SECRETARIAT AND CONFERENCE ACCOMMODATION: A NOTE WILL BE DISTRIBUTED BY THE EXECUTIVE SECRETARY.
5. ADMINISTRATIVE AND FINANCIAL QUESTIONS:
 - (A) GENERAL SERVICE CATEGORY SALARY SCALES (L/2217)
 - (B) ADDITIONAL CONTRIBUTIONS (L/2214 AND L/2218)
6. APPOINTMENT OF COMMITTEES AND WORKING PARTIES:
 - (A) COMMITTEE ON BUDGET, FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION
 - (B) WORKING PARTY ON RELATIONS WITH POLAND
 - (C) WORKING PARTY ON EEC/TURKEY
 - (D) WORKING PARTY ON EEC/AFRICAN STATES ASSOCIATED WITH THE EEC.
7. PROGRAMME OF MEETINGS.
8. ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN.

COUNCIL MEMBERS ARE REQUESTED TO ADVISE ME BY 25 MAY OF THE COMPOSITION OF THEIR DELEGATIONS. CONTRACTING PARTIES AND ASSOCIATED GOVERNMENTS, NOT MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS DESIRING TO BE REPRESENTED BY OBSERVERS SHOULD INFORM ME OF THE NAMES OF THEIR REPRESENTATIVES.
