SUBJECT: TARIFF NEGOTIATIONS BETWEEN GERMANY AND DENMARK

1. THE GOVERNMENTS OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY AND DENMARK HAVE INFORMED THE EXECUTIVE SECRETARY THAT THEY WISH TO ENTER INTO TARIFF NEGOTIATIONS. THESE NEGOTIATIONS WILL BE CONDUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH PROCEDURES ESTABLISHED BY THE CONTRACTING PARTIES AT THE SIXTH SESSION (BASIC INSTRUMENTS AND SELECTED DOCUMENTS, PAGE 116).

2. THE NEGOTIATIONS WILL BEGIN IN GENEVA ON OR ABOUT 5 JUNE 1955. ANY CONTRACTING PARTY WHICH CONSIDERS THAT IT HAS A SUBSTANTIAL INTEREST IN THE NEGOTIATIONS AND THEREFORE WISHES TO NEGOTIATE WITH ONE OR BOTH OF THE PARTIES, SHOULD, BY THE ABOVE DATE, PROPOSE SUCH NEGOTIATIONS TO THE GOVERNMENT OR GOVERNMENTS CONCERNED AND, AT THE SAME TIME, NOTIFY THE SECRETARIAT.
