SUBJECT: TARIFF NEGOTIATIONS, JANUARY 1956

BY LETTER DATED 14 JULY I DREW THE ATTENTION OF CONTRACTING PARTIES TO THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE WORKING PARTY ON TARIFF REDUCTION THAT THE CON-TRACTING PARTIES SHOULD CONVENE A TARIFF NEGOTIATING CONFERENCE TO BEGIN IN JANUARY 1956 AND I INVITED COVERNMENTS WISHING TO TAKE PART IN SUCH A CON-FERENCE TO NOTIFY ME OF THEIR INTENTIONS BY 31 JULY. TO DATE THE FOLLOWING COVERNMENTS HAVE ADVISED THAT THEY INTEND TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CONFERENCE:

DENMARK AUSTRALIA ITALY NORWAY JAPAN AUSTRIA GERMANY SWEDEN LUXEMBURG BELGIUM GREECE UNITED KINGDOM NETHERLANDS UNITED STATES CUBA HAITI

A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE GOVERNMENT OF INDIA HAS INDICATED THAT HIS GOVERNMENT IS READY TO PARTICIPATE BUT EXPECTS THAT THE SCOPE OF ITS NEGOTIATIONS WILL BE LIMITED.

THE FOLLOWING STATEMENTS HAVE BEEN RECEIVED FROM OTHER GOVERNMENTS: THE GOVERNMENT OF FINLAND IS STILL CONSIDERING THE QUESTION OF PARTICIPATION, BUT HAS INFORMED THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES THAT IT WILL NEGOTIATE WITH IT. THE GOVERNMENT OF CHILE IS IN PRINCIPLE READY TO TAKE PART IN THE CONFERENCE BUT HAS NOT YET TAKEN A FINAL DECISION. THE GOVERNMENT OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA ADVISED THAT IT IS ACTIVELY CONSIDERING THE QUESTION OF ITS ON THE OTHER HAND, THE GOVERNMENT OF INDONESIA WILL NOT TAKE PARTICIPATION. PART IN THE NEGOTIATIONS AND THE GOVERNMENT OF TURKEY WILL ALSO ABSTAIN UNLESS THE RULES FOR NEGOTIATION OR THE ACTUAL NEGOTIATIONS WERE TO AFFECT CONCESSIONS GRANTED TO TURKEY.

ALL GOVERNMENTS INTENDING TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CONFERENCE ARE RETHINDED THAT PRELIMINARY LISTS OF PRODUCTS ON WHICH THEY INTEND TO REQUEST CONCESSIONS FROM THE UNITED STATES ARE TO BE SUBMITTED BY 15 AUGUST.
