## NEGOTIATIONS UNDER ARTICLE XXVIII

### Canada

In accordance with the procedure indicated in document GATT/TN.2/A/11, the Canadian Delegation has addressed the following communication to the Executive Secretary:

"The following statement indicates the items in which Canada has a substantial interest and it is based on official notices, received by this date, of withdrawals and modifications proposed by other countries under Article XXVIII. Canada reserves the right to indicate her substantial interest in any further withdrawals or modifications under Article XXVIII, of which notice is received after this date. In particular, this right is reserved respecting any withdrawals or modifications which may result from the Schuman Plan.

"Proposed withdrawals of concessions originally negotiated with Canada are not dealt with in the statement."
