Note by the Secretariat

Addendum

1. Following the decisions of the CONTRACTING PARTIES at their Fortieth and Forty-first Sessions (BISD 31S/222 and 32S/92-93), contracting parties should make complete notifications of their quantitative restrictions every two years and notify details of changes therein as and when they occur.

2. The report of the Technical Group, adopted by the Council at its meeting of 10 May 1989 (C/M/232, page 5), "recommended that the secretariat:

- (i) publish as and when necessary, a list of notifications received and incorporated in the data base;
- (ii) not issue further compilations of notifications in the NTM/W/6/-documentation, but make available to contracting parties, as and when requested, on paper or computer tape, detailed extracts of the quantitative restrictions data base;
- (iii) in accordance with the agreed procedures, up-date the analyses (NTM(TG)/W/5) for the next multilateral review" (L/6492, paragraph 22).

3. The last full compilation of notifications was issued in NTM/W/6/Rev.5 and further notifications in Addenda 1-5. Since then the secretariat has incorporated the following notifications of quantitative restrictions in the data base:
