Annex 5 - Intersessional Committee

Change proposed by the New Zealand Delegation to the Intersessional Procedures as consolidated in the Basic Instruments and Selected Documents, Second Supplement, pages 10-11, and amended in Annex 5

The New Zealand delegation proposes the deletion of the existing paragraph 7 on page 10 of BISD, Second Supplement, Volume II. The numbering of the paragraphs would, as a result of this amendment and the other amendments contained in Annex 5, be changed as follows:

Paragraph 8 on page 10 of the Second Supplement would become paragraph 7.

Paragraphs 9 and 10 in Annex 5 (L/327, p. 43) would become paragraphs 8 and 9.

Paragraph 9 on page 10 of the Second Supplement would become paragraph 10.

The paragraph numbering on page 11 would be changed accordingly.

The new paragraph proposed by the New Zealand delegation to be added to the General Procedures on page 11 would then read as follows:

"Any contracting party which considers that its interests are substantially affected and which is dissatisfied with a decision or determination of the Committee taken pursuant to paragraph 5 or 9 is entitled to call for the decision or determination to be reviewed by the CONTRACTING PARTIES and for a final decision to be taken by them by postal or telegraphic ballot."

The paragraphs to which this refers in the Procedures are paragraph 5 relating to consultations or action under Articles XII to XIV and paragraph 9 relating to applications under Article XXVIII.
