GATT Information Services

The secretariat of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade includes an information office and library, both in the charge of an information officer.

Press Releases. GATT press releases are issued in Geneva through the channel of the information service of the United Nations European Office. All releases are issued in English and French simultaneously. The GATT information office has its own mailing list for releases, which includes UN Headquarters and the regional Information Centres.

Radio. From time to time members of the GATT secretariat and delegates to GATT meetings make use of the radio facilities of the Palais des Nations, Geneva.

<u>Documents</u>. There is no automatic distribution of GATT documents through the information office. Documents, if available, are supplied on request, after they have been "de-restricted".

Photos and Films. There are no films or film strips dealing with the GATT, nor are any photos available, at present.

Publications. GATT publications are not usually available free of charge; an exception for press and radio correspondents only is made for the GATT annual report which contains a survey of world trade developments. GATT publications are, however, available free of charge in limited quantities for the libraries of UN Headquarters and the regional Information Centres. Three mimeographed papers, namely a list of material relating to the GATT, a descriptive information paper "GATT, what it is and what it has done", and a "GATT Bibliography" are all available free of charge, on request.
