Percentage of liberalized imports from the dollar area of OEEC members which are contracting parties to the General Agreement

Explanatory notes

- 1. These figures represent imports liberalized as of 17 September 1955 as percentages of each country's total private imports from the United States and Canada on the basis of actual imports in 1953.
- 2. Although the percentages are calculated on the basis of imports from the United States and Canada, the liberalization is applied by most OEEC countries to all other countries in the dollar area. The lists of countries belonging to the dollar area used, are, however, not identical for all OEEC countries.
- 3. The figures are percentages of imports in 1953, and therefore should not be taken as an indication of the proportion of imports that would be coming into these countries from the United States and Canada in the absence of all restrictions.
