In order to enable observer governments to follow more closely the operation of the General Agreement between sessions, the Executive Secretary has given me instructions to establish a limited distribution of all GATT documents during the intersessional period to those governments which attend regularly the sessions of the CONTRACTING PARTIES. This distribution will be established upon the understanding that all GATT documents are issued as "restricted" and are often of a somewhat confidential nature, and consequently they are for governmental use only, in no case are they available to the public unless it has been announced in the documentation (INF/ series) that they have been derestricted.
