EIGHTH PROTOCOL OF RECTIFICATIONS AND MODIFICATIONSDistribution of Draft

provided that no objections against any points in these lists were outstanding by 31 December 1958.

In paragraph 4 of the Report of the Working Party it was recommended that the above contracting parties send to the Executive Secretary a list of the contracting parties with which points arising out of its submission remained to be settled. Delegations which had cleared their submissions with all contracting parties were asked to inform the Executive Secretary and to notify any amendments which might need to be made in their original submission.

To this date very few notifications have been received. It appears that a number of submissions have not yet been cleared. The attention of contracting parties is therefore called to the rules laid down by the CONTRACTING PARTIES (L/934, paragraph 3) that any items or draft Schedules against which objections are still maintained by 31 December 1958 shall be omitted from

the draft Protocol. It is hoped that most, if not all, differences will be cleared by that date so that it will be possible to circulate the draft Protocol immediately thereafter. In any case, contracting parties which by that date still have objections to any point in the above lists, should notify the secretariat in time for it to withhold the list from the draft Eighth Protocol of Rectifications and Modifications.
