Description: International Trade 1959 is the seventh annual survey of world commerce, prepared by the GATT secretariat.

The survey first reviews Developments in the Structure and Pattern of International Trade during 1959 and provides a Detailed Analysis of Trade between Industrial and Non-industrial Areas. The Trade Developments and Economic Progress of the Non-industrial Areas during the 1950's and Prospects for the Future are examined.

The survey also pays special attention to Recent Developments in the United States Balance of Payments.

As in the earlier surveys, Recent Trends in Commodity Trade are set out, and trade in foodstuffs, raw materials, non-ferrous base metals, fuels and manufactures are analyzed in detail. Among the manufactures which are analyzed are textiles and passenger cars.

Finally the survey provides a detailed discussion of certain fundamental trade problems confronting both the industrial and the non-industrial countries, and reviews the changes in the export earnings of primary producing countries.
