LEAD

The Committee noted the possible barrier to the export earnings of the less-developed countries represented by the existing quantitative restrictions applied by the United States on lead, but discussions were postponed since the difficulties affecting the producers, importers and exporters of lead were at present being studied by the United Nations Lead and Zinc Study Group. The Committee expressed its hope that the efforts of the United Nations Lead and Zinc Study Group would lead to a satisfactory solution to this problem at an early date.
