CERTIFICATION OF RECTIFICATIONS AND MODIFICATIONS

Schedule XIX - United Kingdom

The Government of the United Kingdom has submitted the attached list of rectifications to its Schedules, as contained in the Ninth Protocol of Rectifications and Modifications.

These rectifications will be dealt with in accordance with the procedure laid down at the Tokyo session (L/1169 and SR.15/15).

Notes explaining the reason for the rectification of each item are attached hereto.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

GENEVA 1947

Page 21: ex 16.02

The more favourable description obviates a distinction between poultry and meat pastes on the one hand and poultry and meat offal paste on the other hand.

Page 24: ex 20.02

The theoretically more favourable description (which removes the limitation "In airtight containers") is a correction of a typing error.

Page 35: ex 31.05

The new item completes the transposition into Brussels Nomenclature form of the original concession in favour of "Potassium nitrate (other than synthetic)" which included Chile potash nitrate. In the preparation of the new Schedule the concession was inadvertently limited to tariff heading 28.39.

Page 36: ex 32.09

The new item completes the transposition into Brussels Nomenclature of the original concession in favour of "Synthetic organic dyestuffs (including pigment dyestuffs), whether soluble or insoluble; compounds, preparations and articles manufactured from any such dyestuffs, except any such compounds, preparations and articles as are not suitable for use in dyeing"; in the preparation of the new Schedule the concession was inadvertently limited to tariff heading 32.05.

Page 43: ex 40.10

The more favourable description obviates a distinction between belts and belting.

Page 43: ex 40.11

The new item was inadvertently omitted from the new Schedule.

Page 157: ex 84.07

Typing error. With the insertion of the word "not", this entry correctly reflects the original concession.

Page 163: ex 84.32

The revised description, and in particular the addition of the words "and combinations of one or more of the above machines with cutting machines", completes the transposition into Brussels Nomenclature of the original concession.

Page 166: ex 84.36

The addition of the words "and combinations of one or more of the above machines with machines for the drying of textile fibres of heading No. 84.17" completes the transposition into Brussels Nomenclature of the original concession.

Page 179: ex 87.02

The revised descriptions reflect the original concessions more accurately.

Typing error.

The theoretically more favourable description is introduced for consistency with the terminology used for the concessions, under tariff heading ex 20.02 in the Geneva (1947) Schedule, relating to other vegetables in airtight containers.
