2. Paragraph 6 of document Spec(82)18 should consequently read as follows:

"6. According to the data compiled by the secretariat and subject to any further amendments or changes in classification that may be found necessary, it can be seen that in terms of a rough order of magnitude the figures for imports affected by each of the three different types of measures presented in the list are for 1980 approximately \$0.79 billion for Article XIX measures, \$13 billion for voluntary export restraints and orderly marketing arrangements and \$5.5 billion for other measures."
