AGREED MINUTES

1. Delegations of the People's Republic of China and of the European Economic Community met on 17 December 1982 in Brussels for consultations in accordance with Article 6 of the Agreement between the European Economic Community and the People's Republic of China on trade in textiles products.
2. As a result of these consultations, China agreed to limit on a regional basis its exports under the following categories to an annual restraint level for the year 1983 as set out below:
