Notification under Article 4:4

Modification of the Bilateral Agreement
between the EEC and Pakistan

Note by the Chairman

Attached is a notification received from the Commission of the European Communities concerning a modification of its bilateral agreement with Pakistan. New restraints were introduced on imports of bed linen (Category 20) into France.¹

Agreed Minute

1. Delegations of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan and the European Community met in Brussels on 6/7 August 1984 for consultations in accordance with Article 8 of the Agreement on trade in textiles between Pakistan and the EC initialled on 21 May 1982.
2. As a result of these consultations it was agreed that Pakistan will limit its exports of bed linen (category 20) to the Community's region of France to the following quantitative limits.

1985 : 500 tonnes

1986 : 530 tonnes

3. In respect of the current year, both parties agreed that exports from Pakistan to the same region from 15 August to 31 December 1984 will be limited to an ad hoc quantity of 200 tonnes.
4. It is understood that this ad hoc quantity will be subject to the double checking system provided for in Protocol A of the Agreement.
