This is to confirm my earlier oral notifications that:

- (a) the United States had requested consultations with Yugoslavia on April 30, 1984, pursuant to article 3 of the Arrangement with respect to men's and boys' wool suit-type coats (category 433 part); and
- (b) pending a mutually satisfactory solution, the United States had on September 4, 1984, pursuant to Article 3.5(i) established a restraint limit of 3,184 dozen for the twelve-month period beginning April 30, 1984, and ending on April 29, 1985. A copy of the U.S. note, which includes the detailed factual statement called for in paragraph 3 of article 3 of the arrangement is attached.

Consultations with respect to this category have been scheduled for October 19, 1984, in Geneva. I will inform you of the results as soon as they are available.

I HAVE THE HONCR TO PETER 10 THE ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES, WITH ANNEXES, DONE
AT GENEVA ON DECEMBER 23, 1973 AND EXTENDED BY THE PROTOCCL ADOPTED ON DECEMBER 22, 1961 AT GENEVA (HEREINAFTER
PETER ET TO AS THE ARRANGEMENT) AND THE AGREEMENT RELATING
TO TRADE IN WOOL AND MAN-MADE FIFER SUITS RETWEEN THE
GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AND THE
GOVERNMENT OF THE SOCIALIST FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF YUGOSLAVIA
EFFECTED BY EXCHANGE OF NOTES OCTOPER 26 AND 27, 1979 (THE
AGREEMENT) AS AMENDED.

MY GOVERNMENT HAS NOTED THE SHARP INCREASE IN IMPORTS OF WOCL SUIT-TYPE COATS FOR MEN AND BOYS FROM YUGOSLAVIA. MY GOVERNMENT HAS CONCLUPED THAT THESE IMPORTS ARE DISFUPTING THE UNITED STATES MARKET AND ARE IMPEDING THE ORDERLY DEVELOPMENT OF TRADE AS CONTEMPLATED UNDER ARTICLE THREE OF THE ARRANGEMENT. A DETAILED FACTUAL STATEMENT OF THE REASONS AND JUSTIFICATION FOR THIS CONCLUSION, WITH CURPFNT SUPPORTING DATA, IS ENCLOSED AS ANNEX A. ACCORDINGLY. THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA HEREPY REQUESTS CONSULTATIONS WITH THE GOVERNMENT OF THE SOCIALIST FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF YUGOSLAVIA TO TISCUSS AN APPROPRIATE LEVEL OF RESTRAINT FOR EXPORTS IN CATEGORY 433 FROM YUGOSLAVIA TO THE UNITED STATES.

-- IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE THREE OF THE ARRANGEMENT.
TO WHICH BOTH THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES AND THE
GOVERNMENT OF YUGOSLAVIA ARE PARTIES, IF OUR TWO GOVERNMENTS ARE UMABLE TO AGREE ON A MUTUALLY SATISFACTORY

SCLUTION TO THIS MATTER WITHIN SIXTY DAYS, THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES RESERVES THE RIGHT TO RESTRAIN SUCH IMPORTS PRODUCED IN YUGOSLAVIA AND EXPORTED DURING THE IWELVE MORTH PERIOD PEGINNING ON THE DATE OF YOUR PECEIPT OF THIS REQUEST, TO A LEVEL NOT LESS THAN THE LEVEL OF THE UNITED STATES IMPORTS FROM YUGOSLAVIA DURING THE FIRST TWELVE MORTHS OF THE MOST KECENT FOURTEEN MONTHS PRECEDING THE MONTH IN WHICH THE REQUEST FOR CONSULTATIONS WAS MADE, THAT IS THE PENICD FERRUARY 1, 1983 THROUGH JANUARY 31, 1984. THIS LEVEL IS 3,184 DOZEN FOR CATEGORY 433.

-- MY COVERNMENT WOULD APPRECIATE THE VIEWS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF YUGOSLAVIA WITH RESPECT TO THE SITUATION PERTAINING TO EXPORTS OF CATEGORY 433 TO THE UNITED STATES AND SETTING A MUTUALLY AGREEABLE TIME AND VENUE FOR CONSULTATIONS.
