

Dear Mr. Chairman:

Pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 4 of Article 4 of the Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Textiles, I am instructed by my government to inform the Textiles Surveillance Body of a further amendment to the bilateral cotton textile agreement between the United States and the Socialist Republic of Romania.

This amendment converts designated consultation levels for categories 347 and 348 (cotton trousers) to a merged-category specific limit for the second agreement year (1984) as shown below:

	Former DCL (DOZ)	New Specific Limit (DOZ)
Category Category	167,282 78,652	249,934

Growth is at seven percent for the remainder of the agreement; swing is at seven percent and carryover/carry forward is at 11/6 percent.

This new restraint, which is set out in an attachment to this letter, was agreed in order to meet Romanian desires for greater access for these products without at the same time incurring a real risk of market disruption.

UNITED STATES AND THE SOCIALIST REPUBLIC OF ROMANIA AMEND BILATERAL TEXTILE AGREEMENT RELATING TO TRADE IN COTTON TEXTILES

The United States and the Socialist Republic of Romania exchanged notes in Washington dated December 5 and December 12, 1984, respectively, to effect amendment to their bilateral textile agreement relating to trade in cotton textiles. Texts of the notes follow:

UNITED STATES NOTE

Washington December 5, 1984

His Excellency Mircea Malitza Ambassador of The Socialist Republic of Romania

Excellency:

I have the honor to refer to the Arrangement regarding International Trade in Textiles, with annexes, done at Geneva on December 20, 1973 and extended by protocols adopted respectively on December 14, 1977 and December 22, 1981, at Geneva (hereinafter referred to as the Arrangement)

and to the Agreement between the Socialist Republic of Romania and the United States of America relating to trade in Cotton Textiles, with annexes, effected by exchange of notes January 28 and March 31, 1983 (hereinafter referred to as the Cotton Agreement). I also refer to recent discussions between representatives of our Governments concerning exports of textile products from Romania to the United States.

Pursuant to those discussions, and in accordance with the Arrangement and the Cotton Agreement. I have the honor, on behalf of my Government, to propose the following with respect to the Cotton Agreement:

1. That Categories 347 and 348 be merged as Category 347/8 in paragraph 4(c) with Specific Limits as follows:

2. That Categories 347 and 348 shall be deleted from paragraph 5(B).

If this proposal is acceptable to your Government this note and your Excellency's note of confirmation shall constitute an amendment to the Cotton Agreement.
