#### Letter to Chairman, TSB, from Permanent Mission of Haiti

Geneva, 26 August 1985

Mr. Chairman,

With reference to your letter of 14 May 1985, regarding restrictions on textile products covered by the Arrangement, I have the honour to convey to you the following information from the Ministry of Trade of the Republic of Haiti.

Attached hereto is a detailed table showing the information currently available.

As regards the duration of the quota restrictions on textile products, the Presidential Order of September 1983 did not establish any time limit, it being understood implicitly, as provided for in Section B of Article XVIII of the General Agreement, that these restrictions will be eliminated when conditions no longer justify their maintenance.

Used clothing is prohibited for import under the Decree of 22 November 1982. This measure falls within the provisions of Article XVIII of the General Agreement - "General exceptions".

Lastly, I wish to advise you that the information requested on the quantity and/or value of imports of the products concerned for the period 1982/1985 will be communicated at a later date.
