This will confirm my earlier oral notification that the United States has decided, effective July 2, 1987, to impose unilateral restraints on imports of two products from China: vegetable fiber suit-type coats (category 833) and silk blend and vegetable fiber trousers (category 847) for one year periods beginning on 30 September 1986 and 31 December 1986, respectively. I am attaching for the information of the TSB copies of the requests for consultations and their accompanying factual statements of the reasons and justification therefore, which were delivered to China prior to China's acceding to the 1986 protocol.

(CCMPLIMENTARY CPENING)

I PAVE TPE ECNCR TO REFER TO THE ARRANGEMENT PEGAPLING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES, WITH ANNEXES, TONE AT GENEVA ON LECEMBER 27, 1973 AND EXTENDED BY PROTOCOL ADOPTED ON DECEMBER 22, 1981 AND JULY 31, 1986 AT GENEVA (HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE ARRANGEMENT). I ALSO REFER TO SECTION 224 OF THE U.S. AGRICULTURAL ACT OF 1956. AS AMENDED.

MY GOVERNMENT HAS NOTEL THE SHARP INCREASE IN IMPORTS OF VEGETABLE FIBER SULT-TYPE COATS CATEGORY RESERVED OF CHINA. MY GOVERNMENT HAS CONCLUDED THAT THESE IMPORTS ARE DISPUPIING THE UNITED STATES' MARKET AND APE IMPETING THE CROFRLY DEVELOPMENT OF TRADE AS CONTEMPLATED BY ARTICLE THEFE OF THE ARRANGEMENT. A DETAILED FACTUAL STATEMENT OF THE REASONS AND JUSTIFICATION FOR THIS CONCLUSION, WITH CURRENT SUFFORTING DATA IS ENCLOSED AS ANNEX A. ACCORDINGLY, THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES REPERY REQUESTS CONSULTATIONS WITH THE GOVERNMENT OF PROFILE'S REFUBILO OF CHINA TO DISCUSS AN APPROPRIATE LEVEL OF RESTRAINT FOR EXPORTS IN CATEGORY 823 FROM CHINA.

IN ACCORIANCE WITH APTICIE THREE OF THE ARRANGEMENT, IF OUP TWO GOVERNMENTS ARE UNABLE TO AGREE ON A MUTUALLY SATISFACTORY SCIUTION TO THIS MATTER WITHIN SIXTY DAYS, THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES BESERVES THE RIGHT TO HESTRAIN SUCH IMPORTS FRODUCED IN CHINA AND EXPORTED DURING THE TWEIVE-MONTH PERIOD REGINNING ON THE DATE OF PECTIPI OF THIS REQUEST, TO A LEVEL NOT LESS THAN THE LITTLE OF THE UNITED STATES' IMPORTS FROM CHINA PUPING THE FIRST IWHLVE OF THE MOST RECENT FOURTEEN MONTHS PRECEDING THE MONTH IN WHICH THE RECUEST FOR CONSULTATIONS WAS MADE, THAT IS, THE PERIOD JULY 1, 1985 TO JUNE 30, 1986. THIS LEVEL IS 11,210 TOZEN FOR CATEGORY 833.

MY GOVERNMENT WOULD APPRECIATE THE VIEWS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PHOPIE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA WITH RESPECT TO THE SITUATION PERTAINING TO EXECRTS OF CATEGORY 933 TO THE UNITED STATES AND TO THE SETTING OF A MUTUALLY AGREAFIF TIME AND VENUE FOR CONSULTATIONS.

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

U.S. IMPORTS OF CATEGORY 833 FROM CHINA WERE 6,848 DOZFN DURING THE FIRST SEVEN MONTHS OF 1986 COMPARED TO 2,268 TOZFN IMPORTED DURING THE FIRST SEVEN MONTHS OF 1985. A 202 PERCENT INCREASE. CHINA IS THE SECOND LARGEST SUPPLIES OF CATEGORY 833 ACCOUNTING FOR 18 PERCENT OF TOTAL IMPORTS DURING THE YEAR FNDING JULY 1986.

IMPORTS OF SILK-BIRND MEN'S AND BOYS' SUIT-TYPE JACKETS AND MEN'S AND BOYS' SUIT-TYPE JACKETS OF VEGETABLE TIBERS OTHER THAN COTTON BAVE INCREASED DRAMATICALLY IN RECENT YEARS. THE PERCOMINATE BLENDS BEING IMPORTED ARE PAMIF/COTTON BLENDS AND LINEN BLENDED WITH VARIOUS FIRES I.S. SILK, RAMIE AND ACRYLIC. IN SOME CASES THREE FIBERS ARE BLENDED. ALSO, A NUMBER OF SILK-BLEND MEN'S AND BOYS' SUIT-TYPE JACKETS ARE BEING IMPORTED.

IMPORTS OF SILKBLEND AND OTHER VEGETABLE FIRER MEN'S AND BOYS' SUIT-TYPE JACKETS COMPETE WITH DOMESTICALLY PROTUCED COTTON, WOOL, AND MAN-MADE FIBER MEN'S AND FOYS' SUIT-TYPE JACKETS. THE U.S. MARKET FOR COTTON, WOOL, AND MAN-MADE FIBER MEN'S AND BOYS' SUIT-TYPE JACKETS. CATEGORY 223/433/633, HAS BEEN DISRUPTED BY IMPORTS. THE SHAPP AND SUBSTANTIAL INCREASE OF CATEGORY 633 IMPORTS FROM CHINA IS CONTRIBUTING TO THE DISRUPTION OF THIS MARKET.

IMPORT PENTTRATION AND MARKET SHARE

THE RATIC OF IMPORTS TO PRODUCTION IN CATEGORY 333/433/633, COTTON, WOOL AND MAN-MADE FIBER MEN'S AND BOYS' SUIT-TYPE JACKETS, INCREASED TO 49 PERCENT IN 1985. THE SHARE OF THIS MARKET HELD BY COMESTIC MANUFACTURERS DROPPED TO 67 PERCENT IN 1985. IMPORTS OF CATEGORY 833 ARE CONTRIBUTING TO THIS MARKET DISRUPTION.

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U.S. IMPORTS OF CATEGORY 833 WERE 55,220 DOZEN IN 1985. THEY INCREASED IN 1986, REACHING 39,022 DOZEN IN THE FIRST SEVEN MONTHS, 29 PERCENT HIGHER THAN THE JANUARY-JULY 1985 LEVEL.

WHEN CATEGORY 333/433/633/833 IMPORTS ARE EXPRESSED AT A 1986 ANNUAL PATE, THE IMPORT TO PRODUCTION RATIO INCREASES TO 56 PERCENT AND THE DOMESTIC MANUFACTURERS' SHARF OF THIS MARKET FAILS TO 64 PERCENT.

TUTY-PAIR VALUE AND U.S. PRODUCER PRICE

ALL OF THE IMPORTS OF CATEGORY 832 FROM CHINA DURING THE FIRST SEVEN MONTES OF 1986 ENTERED UNDER TSUSA NUMBERS 381.6987 -- MEN'S AND BOYS' SULT-TYPE JACKETS, OF VEGETAPLE FIRER CTHER THAN COTTON, NOT KNIT, NOT CRNAMENTED; AND 381.8682 - MEN'S AND EOYS' SILKFIEND SILK-TYPE JACKETS, NOT KNIT, NOT CRNAMENTED. THESE SULT-TYPE JACKETS ENTERED THE U.S. AT LANDED DUTY-PAID VALUES BELOW U.S. FRODUCERS' PRICES FOR COMPARABLE SULT-TYPE JACKETS.

THE EMBASSY OF THE UNITED STATES HAS THE HONOR TO REFER TO THE ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES, WITH ANNEXES, DONE AT GENEVA ON DECEMBER 20. 1973 AND EXTENDED BY PROTOCOLS ADOPTED RESPECTIVELY ON DECEMBER 14, 1977, DECEMBER 22, 1981 AND JULY 31, 1986 AT. GENEVA (THE ARRANGEMENT). THE EMBASSY ALSO REFERS TO SECTION 204 OF THE U.S. AGRICULTURAL ACT OF 1956. AS

AMFNDED.

DURING RECENT MONTHS THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT HAS NOTED THE SHARPLY RISING LEVEL OF IMPORTS OF CATEGORY 847 SILK BLEND AND VEGETABLE FIBER TROUSERS FROM CHINA TO THE UNITED STATES. AFTER CAREFUL REVIEW, THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT HAS CONCLUDED THAT IMPORTS IN THIS CATEGORY ARE DISRUPTING THE UNITED STATES MARKET AND ARE IMPEDING THE ORDERLY DEVELOPMENT OF TRADE AS CONTEMPLATED BY ARTICLE 3 OF THE ARRANGEMENT.

A DETAILED FACTUAL STATEMENT OF THE REASONS AND JUSTIFICATION FOR THIS CONCLUSION, WITH CURRENT DATA, IS INCLUDED AS AN ENCLOSURE TO THIS NOTE. ACCORDINGLY, THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT REQUESTS CONSULTATIONS WITH THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA TO DISCUSS AN APPROPRIATE LEVEL OF RESTRAINT FOR EXPORTS IN CATEGORY 847 FROM CHINA.

IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 3 OF THE ARRANGEMENT, IF OUR TWO GOVERNMENTS ARE UNABLE TO AGREE ON A MUTUALLY SATISFACTORY SOLUTION TO THIS MATTER WITHIN SIXTY DAYS, THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES RESERVES THE RIGHT TO RESTRAIN SUCH IMPORTS PRODUCED IN CHINA AND EXPORTED

DURING THE TWELVE MONTH PERIOD BEGINNING ON THE DATE OF RECEIPT OF THIS REQUEST, TO A LEVEL NOT LESS THAN THE LEVEL OF THE UNITED STATES' IMPORTS FROM CHINA DURING THE FIRST TWELVE OF THE MOST RECENT FOURTEEN MONTHS PRECEEDING THE MONTH IN WHICH THE REQUEST FOR CONSULTATIONS WAS MADE, THAT IS THE PERIOD CCTCBER 1, 1985 TO SEPTEMBER 30, 1986. THIS LEVEL IS 703,358 DOZEN FOR CATEGORY 847.

THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT WOULD APPRECIATE THE VIEWS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CRINA WITH RESPECT TO THE SITUATION PERTAINING TO THE EXPORT OF CATEGORY 847 TO THE UNITED STATES AND TO THE SETTING OF A MUTUALLY AGREEABLE TIME AND VENUE FOR CONSULTATIONS.

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SUMMARY ANT CONCLUSIONS

U.S. IMPORTS OF CATEGORY 847 FROM CHINA WERE 634,623 DOZEN DURING THE FIRST TEN MONTHS OF 1985 COMPARED TO 542,733 DOZEN IMPORTED DURING THE FIRST TEN MONTHS OF 1985. A 17 PERCENT INCREASE. CHINA IS THE LARGEST SUPPLIER OF CATEGORY 847 ACCOUNTING FOR 56 PERCENT OF TOTAL IMPORTS DURING THE FIRST TEN MONTHS OF 1986.

IMPORTS OF SILKBLEND AND VEGETABLE FIBER OTHER THAN COTTON TROUSERS, SLACKS, AND SHORTS HAVE INCREASED DRAMATICALLY IN RECENT YEARS. THE PREDOMINATE BLEND FING IMPORTED IS RAMIE/COTTON. MOST OF THE CATEGORY E47 IMPORTS FROM CHINA ARE RAMIE/COTTON TROUSERS, SLACKS, AND SHORTS.

IMPORTS OF SILV-BLEND AND OTHER VEGETABLE F1EER
TPOJSERS, SLACKS AND SHORTS COMPETE WITH COMESTICALLY
PRODUCED COTTON, WOOL, AND MAN-MADE FIBER TROUSERS,
SLACKS AND SHORTS. THE U.S. MARKET FOR COTTON, WOOL,
AND MAN-MADE FIBER TROUSERS, SLACKS AND SHORTS, CATFGORY
E47/348/447/448/647/648, HAS BEEN DISRUPTED BY IMPORTS.

THE SUBSTANTIAL INCREASE OF CATEGORY 847 IMPORTS FROM CHINA IS CONTRIBUTING TO THE DISPUPTION OF THIS MARIET.

IMPORT PENETRATION AND MARKET SHARE

THE RATIO OF IMPORTS TO PRODUCTION IN CATEGORY 347/348/447/448/547/548, COTTON, WOOL, AND MAN-MADE FIBER TROUSERS, SLACKS AND SEORTS, INCREASED TO 48 PERCENT IN 1985. THE SHARE OF THIS MARKET HELD BY DOMESTIC MANUFACTURERS PROPPED TO 68 PERCENT IN 1985. IMPORTS OF CATEGORY 847 APE CONTRIBUTING TO THIS MARKET FISHUPTION.

U.S. IMPORTS OF CATEGORY 947 MERE 1,225,000 DOZEN IN 1985. THEY INCREASED IN 1988 REACHING 1,130,600 DOZEN IN THE FIRST TEN MONTHS, 14 PERCENT HIGHER TEAM THE JAMUARYOCTOBER 1985 LEVEL.

PROTUCTION DATA FOR 1985 ARE NOT CURRENTLY AVAILABLE;
