Dear Mr. Raffaelli,

I refer to your letter of November 5, 1987, in which  
you request that we provide the Textile Surveillance  
Body with further information concerning our  
notification made under Article 11 of the MFA.

Swedish restraints on imports of certain products  
from Czechoslovakia, Hungary, Poland and Romania are  
bilaterally agreed quotas. The present arrangements  
are maintained due to the difficult situation in the  
Swedish textile industry. They are in accordance  
with the relevant protocols of accession to the GATT  
and the bilateral long term agreements with the  
countries concerned.
