COTTON AND MAN-MADE FIBER SKIRTS ARE AN IMPORT SENSITIVE TEXTILE PRODUCT IN THE UNITED STATES. PURSUANT TO THE ARRANGEMENT AND CONSISTENT WITH THE GCALS SET OUT IN ARTICLE TEREE OF THE ARRANGEMENT TO ACHIEVE THE EYPANSION OF TRADE WHILE AT THE SAME TIME ENSURING AVOIDANCE OF DISRUPTIVE EFFECTS, THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES HAS NEGOTIATED LEVELS OF TRADE FOR THESE PRODUCTS WITH MANY EXPORTING COUNTPIES OP HAS REQUESTED CONSULTATIONS TO REACH SUCH NEGOTIATED LEVELS OF TRADE. IMPORTS FROM TURKEY OF THESE SKIRTS HAVE INCREASED BY 214 PERCENT IN THE YEAR ENDING FEFTUARY 1987 TO A LEVEL OF 119.550 DOZEN. THE LEVEL OF IMPORTS FROM TUPKEY IS DISPUPTING THE U.S. MARKET. IMPORTS FROM TUPKEY. WHOSE PRICES ARE WELL FELOW THOSE PREVAILING IN THE U.S. MARKET, IF

SINFLICT FURTHER SERIOUS DAMAGE TO U.S. MANUFACTURERS.

"IA DESCRIPTION OF THE FFECTS OF SUCH IMPORTS ON THE UNITED STATES MAPKET, THE RECENT TRENDS OF SUCH IMPORTS FROM TURKEY AND A TAPLE OF IMPORTS AND DOMESTIC PRICE DATA ARE ENCLOSED AS ANNEX A WHICH IS TO BE REGARDED AS AN INTEGRAL PART OF THIS NOTE.

IN OPDER TO ALLEVIATE MARKET DISRUPTION. THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES HEREBY FEQUESTS CONSULTATIONS WITH THE GOVERNMENT OF TURKFY TO DISCUSS APPROPRIATE LEVELS OF RESTRAINT FOR ITS EXPORTS OF CATEGORY 342/642 PROTUCTS ENTERING THE UNITED STATES.

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES LOOKS FORWARD TO REACHING A MUTUALLY SATISFACTORY SOLUTION OF THIS MATTER IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ARRANGEMENT. IF OUR TWO GOVERNMENTS ARE UNABLE TO AGREE ON A MUTUALLY SATISFACTORY AGREEMENT WITHIN SIXTY DAYS, THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES RESERVES THE RIGHT TO RESTRAIN IMPORTS OF COTTON AND MAN-MADE FIFTR SKIRTS IN CATEGORY 342/642 PRODUCED IN TURKEY AND EXPORTED DURING THE TWELVE

MONTH PERIOD BEGINNING ON THE DATE OF YOUR RECEIPT OF THIS REQUEST, TO A LEVEL NOT LESS THAN THE LEVEL OF UNITED STATES IMPORTS OF THIS PRODUCT FROM TURKEY DURING THE FIRST TWELVE OF THE MOST RECENT FOURTEEN MONTHS PRECEDING THE MONTH IN WHICH THIS REQUEST IS MADE. THIS LEVEL IS 119,550 DOZEN, BASED ON THE YEAR ENDING FEBRUARY 1987 IMPORT DATA.

THE GOVERMENT OF THE UNITED STATES WOULD APPRECIATE THE VIEWS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF TURKEY PERTAINING TO THE SITUATION CONCERNING EXPORTS OF CATEGORY 342/642 SKIRTS FROM TURKEY TO THE UNITED STATES AND REGARDING A DATE AND PLACE FOR CONSULTATIONS.

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

U.S. IMPORTS OF CATEGORY 342/642 FROM TURKEY WERE 119,550 DOZEN DURING THE YEAR ENDING FEBRUARY 1987. MORE THAN THREE TIMES THE 38,030 DOZEN IMPORTED A YEAR EARLIER. DURING 1986. IMPORTS OF CATEGORY 342/642 FROM TURKEY REACHED 60,187 DOZEN COMPARED TO 31,350 DOZEN IMPORTED DURING 1985. A 92 PERCENT INCREASE.

THE MARKET FOR CATEGORY 342/642 HAS BEEN DISRUPTED BY IMPORTS. THE SHARP AND SUBSTANTIAL INCREASE IN IMPORTS FROM TURKEY HAS CONTRIBUTED TO THIS DISPUPTION:
