Dear Sir,

Pursuant to Article 4:4 of the Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Textiles as extended by the 1986 Protocol, I am pleased to notify the Textiles Surveillance Body of a modification made in the bilateral agreement between the Government of the Kingdom of Norway and the Federal Executive Council of the Assembly of the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia.

The agreement which covers the period 1 January - 31 December 1990, was initialled in Belgrade 11 November 1987, implemented on a provisional basis from 1 January 1988, and signed in Belgrade 18 January 1988.

The agreed restraint level for category 7 Bed linen was 20 000 kgs.

Norway has the intention to gradually liberalize its textile restraints. For this purpose consultations were held with Yugoslavia 13 - 14 October 1988. As a result of these consultations the restraint level for cat 7 was increased from 20 000 kgs to 30 000 kgs i.e. by 50 per cent.

### Amendment

to the Agreement relating to the exports from the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia of certain textile products for imports into Norway, signed in Belgrade on 18 January 1988

During consultations held in Belgrade on 13 - 14 October 1988 in accordance with Paragraph 15 of the Agreement, Norway and the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia agreed to the following amendment:

In annex B the restraint level for cat. No. 7 under (b) to be increased from 20.000 kgs to 30.000 kgs.
