2 I would like to inform you that Singapore does
not maintain any quantitative restrictions on the textiles
and textile products imported into Singapore.

3 With respect to its exports of textiles and
textile products, Singapore has concluded 5 bilateral
textiles agreements with the following MFA participating
countries under Article 4:
