Dear Mr. Raffaelli,

I am referring to your letter of 28 February this year concerning the submittion of the information under Article 11 of the Arrangement. Upon the instructions from my authorities I to advise you on the following.

The import of textiles to Poland is not subject to any restrictions. There are no import quotas on textiles in force. All enterprises operating in Poland, including private firms, are entitled to engage directly in import operations without prior administrative authorization. As a result no limits exist with regard to a number of importers who have the right to purchase textiles abroad.
