This is to confirm my earlier oral notification that, effective December 12, 1989, the United States invoked the provisions of article 3.5 of the MFA to impose restraints on imports of two textile products from Thailand: cotton sheeting (category 313) and cotton printcloth (category 315). The restraint period for each category is from March 31, 1989 to March 30, 1990. The restraints are set at 11,712,810 square meters for category 313 and at 15,375,452 square meters for category 315.

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THE SECRETARY OF STATE PRESENTS HIS COMPLIMENTS TO THE AMBASSADOR OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND AND REFERS TO THE ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEITILES, WITH ANNEXES, DONE AT GENEVA ON DECEMBER 20, 1973 AND EXTENDED BY PROTOCOLS ADOPTED RESPECTIVELY ON DECEMBER 14, 1977, DECEMBER 22, 1981 AND JULY 31, 1986 AT GENEVA (THE ARRANGEMENT). THE SECRETARY FURTHER REFERS TO SECTION 204 OF THE U.S. AGRICULTURAL ACT OF 1956. AS AMENDED.

DURING RECENT MONTHS THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES HAS NOTED THE SHARPLY RISING LEVEL OF EXPORTS OF COTTON PRINTCLOTH (CATEGORY 315) TO THE UNITED STATES FROM THAILAND. AFTER CAREFUL REVIEW, THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT HAS CONCLUDED THAT IMPORTS IN THIS CATEGORY ARF DISRUPTING THE UNITED STATES MARKET AS CONTEMPLATED BY ARTICLF 3 OF THE ARRANGEMENT. A DETAILED FACTUAL STATEMENT OF THE REASONS AND JUSTIFICATION FOR THIS CONCLUSION, WITH CURRENT DATA, IS ENCLOSED AS ANNEX A OF MATTS HEREBY REQUESTS CONSULTATIONS WITH THE GOVERNMENT OF THAILAND TO DISCUSS AN APPROPRIATE LEVEL OF RESTRAINT FOR THAILAND SEXPORTS TO THE UNITED STATES OF COTTON PRINTCLOTH (CATEGORY 315).

IN ACCORDANCE WITH APTICLE 3 OF THE ARRANGEMENT, IF PFPRESPNTATIVES OF THE TWO GOVERNMENTS ARE UNABLE TO AGREE ON A MUTUALLY SATISFACTORY SOLUTION TO THIS MATTER WITHIN SIXTY DAYS, THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES RESERVES THE RIGHT TO RESTRAIN SUCH IMPORTS PRODUCED IN THAILAND AND EXPORTED DURING THE TWELVE MONTH PERIOD BEGINNING ON THE DATE OF RECEIPT OF THIS REQUEST. THIS LIMIT WILL NOT BE LESS THAN 15,375,452 SQUARE METERS. THIS FIGURE IS BASED ON THE PREVIOUS RESTRAINT LEVEL OF 18,388,888 SQUARE YARDS CONVERTED TO SQUARE METERS WITH THE CONVERSION FACTOR OF \$\Omega\$.83612736 SQUARE METER PER SQUARE YARD.

TO GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES WOULD APPRECIATE THE VITWS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND WITH RESPECT TO THAILAND'S EXPORTS OF CATEGORY 315 TO THE UNITED STATES AND REGARDING A DATE AND PLACE FOR CONSULTATIONS.

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

U.S. IMPORTS OF COTTON PRINTCLOTH -- CATEGORY 315 -- FROM THAILAND SURGED TO 1.665,956 SQUARE METERS IN JANUARY 1989. THAILAND WAS THE FIFTH LARGEST SUPPLIER OF CATEGORY 315 AND THE LARGEST UNCONTROLLED SUPPLIER, ACCOUNTING FOR 6 PERCENT OF TOTAL IMPORTS IN JANUARY 1989. THERE WERE NO IMPORTS FROM THAILAND IN JANUARY 1988.

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THE U.S. MARKET FOR COTTON PRINTCLOTH IS BEING DISRUPTED BY THE SHARP AND SUBSTANTIAL INCREASE OF IMPORTS FROM THAILAND.
