MEN'S AND BOYS' AND WOMEN'S AND GIRLS' MAN-MADE FIBER KNIT SHIRTS AND BLOUSES CATEGORY 638/639

I. PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

CATEGORY 638/639 COVERS MEN'S AND BOYS' AND WOMEN'S AND GIRLS' MAN-MADE FIBER KNIT SHIRTS AND BLOUSES. CATEGORY 638/639 KNIT GARMENTS ARE COMMERCIALLY KNOWN AS BLOUSES, SPORT OR DRYSS SHIRTS, POLO SHIRTS, PULLOVERS, SHELLS, HALTERS OR TOPS, TURTLENECK SHIRTS, SWEATSHIRTS, T-SHIRT, OR TANK TOPS. THESE OUTERGARMENTS FOR MALES AND FEMALES COVER THE UPPERBODY FROM THE NECK OR SHOULDERS TO THE WAIST OR BELOW. AS FAR AS THE MID-THIGH AREA.

CATTGORY 638/639 KNIT GARMENTS MAY HAVE A COLLAR TREATMENT, INCLUDING A FOOD, OR NO COLLAR, AND MAY HAVE ANY TYPE OF NECKLINE. THESE GARMENTS MAY BE A PULLOVER STYLE OR HAVE A FULL OR PARTIAL FRONT OR BACK OPENING. THEY MAY BE SLEEVELESS OR HAVE SLEEVES OF ANY LENGTH AND MAY HAVE ANY TYPE OF POCKET TREATMENT. THE BOTTOMS OF THESE KNIT GARMENTS ARE USUALLY HEMMED; HOWEVER, THEY MAY BE FINISHED IN OTHER WAYS TO PREVENT RAVELLING. THE CONSTRUCTION OF THESE KNIT SHIRTS AND BLOUSES MAY BE TAILORED OR FULL-FASHIONED.

II. MARKET SITUATION

- A. MARKET DISRUPTION
- 1. U.S. PRODUCTION (TABLE I)

U.S. PRODUCTION OF MEN'S AND BOYS' AND WOMFN'S AND GIRLS' MAN-MADE FIBER KNIT SHIRTS AND BLOUSES DECLINED FROM 61,726 THOUSAND DOZEN IN 1987 TO 59,544 THOUSAND DOZEN IN 1988, A DECLINE OF 4 PERCENT. DURING THE FIRST NINE MONTHS OF 1989, PRODUCTION OF MAN-MADE FIBER KNIT SHIRTS DROPPED TO 39,227 THOUSAND DOZEN. 13 PERCENT BELOW THE 45,086 THOUSAND DOZEN PRODUCED IN THE SAME PERIOD OF 1988.

2. MARKET SHARF LOSS (TAPLE I)

THE U.S. PRODUCERS' SHARE OF THE MARKET FOR DOMESTICALLY PRODUCED AND IMPORTED MEN'S AND BOYS' AND WOMEN'S AND GIRLS' MAN-MADE FIBER KNIT SEIRTS AND FLOUSES. AT 59 PERCENT FOR THE FIRST NINE MONTHS OF 1989, WAS DOWN 12 PERCENTAGE POINTS FROM THE 71 PERCENT FOR THE SAME PERIOD A YEAR EARLIER.

THE RATIO OF IMPORTS TO DOMESTIC PRODUCTION INCREASED 28 PERCENTAGE POINTS IN THE FIRST NINE MONTHS OF 1989. INCREASING FROM 41 PERCENT DURING THE FIRST NINE MONTHS OF 1988 TO 69 PERCENT DURING THE FIRST NINE MONTHS OF 1989.

4. FMPLOYMENT

TOTAL EMPLOYMENT IN THE U.S. INDUSTRY WHICH PRODUCES KNIT OUTERWEAR (SIC 2253) DECLINED 3 PERCENT FROM 72.1 THOUSAND EMPLOYEES IN 1987 TO 70.2 THOUSAND EMPLOYEES IN 1989.

- B. SPARP AND SUBSTANTIAL INCREASES IN IMPORTS
- 1. IMPORTS (GENERAL) (TABLE II)

AFTER U.S. IMPORTS OF CATEGORY 638/639 DECLINED IN 1988, IMPORTS SURGED IN 1989, REACHING 34,996,300 DOZEN, UP 14 PERCENT OVER THE 1987 LEVEL.

- 2. IMPORTS (THAILAND) (TABLE II)
 - A. U.S. IMPORTS OF CATEGORY 638/639 FROM THAILAND DECLINED IN 1988. THAILAND'S CATEGORY 638/639 IMPORTS THEN SURGED IN 1989 TO A RECORD LEVEL 1,940,159 DOZEN. DOUBLE THEIR 1988 LEVEL AND 52 PERCENT ABOVE THEIR 1987 LEVEL.
 - B. APPROXIMATELY 80 PERCENT OF THAILAND'S MEN'S AND BOYS' AND WOMEN'S AND GIRLS' MAN-MADE FIBER KNIT SHIRT AND PLOUSE IMPORTS IN 1989 ENTERED UNDER STSUSA NUMBERS 6105.20.2030 -- BOYS' MAN-MADE FIBER KNIT SHIRTS.
 6110.30.3040 -- MEN'S AND BOYS' MAN-MADE FIBER SWEATSHIRTS. 6110.30.3050 -- MEN'S AND BOYS' MAN-MADE FIBER KNIT PULLOVERS,
 6106.20.2010 -- WOMEN'S MAN-MADE FIBER KNIT SHIRTS AND BLOUSES. AND 6110.30.3055 -- WOMEN'S AND GIRLS' MAN-MADE FIBER KNIT PULLOVERS.

- U.S. MAPKET FOR DOMESTICALLY PRODUCED AND IMPORTED MEN'S AND BOYS AND WOMEN'S AND GIRLS MAN-MADE FIBER WHIT SHIRTS AND PLOUSES. EXPORT DATA ARE QUESTIONABLE DUE TO REPORTING PROBLEMS. NEVERTHELESS, INDICATIONS ARE THAT EXPORTS ARE NOT A SIGNIFICANT FACTOR IN DETERMINING THIS MARKET.
