ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES
Notification under Article 4
Modification of the Bilateral Agreement
Between the EEC and the People's Republic of China
Note by the Chairman

Attached is a notification received from the EEC of a modification of its bilateral agreement with the People's Republic of China resulting from the implementation of the Harmonized System.

[^0]Dear Ambassador,
In connection with the European Economic Community's Agreements in textlle products with Hong Kong, Philippines, Thailand, Pakistan, India and China negotiated under Article 4 of the Arrangement, I have to Inform you of the following.

Between 1987 and 1989, the Community had several consultation meetings with the above mentloned countries in order to adjust the quantitative IImits for a number of products affected by the Implementation of the Harmonized System In accordance with Paragraph 18 of the Protocol extending the Arrangement.

The modified quantitative IImits contalned in the Agreed Minutes annexed to this letter are herewith communicated under Article 4 paragraph 4 of the Arrangement, as a modification to Community's Agreements with Hong Kong, Phllippines, Thailand, Pakistan, India and China.

The Community intended to present these modifications once it had completed its consultations with all the countrles concerned. However, since the consultation with one country has been inconclusive, the Community prefers to present the above mentioned modifications without further delay.


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## AGREED MINUTE

1. 

A Melecation of the People's Penutilic of China and a Delegation of the Eurodean Economic Community met in Zrussels from 25 September to 13 nctoher 1989 and from 11 to 13 December 1989 in accordance with the Drovisions of article 16 of the Agreement between the European Economic Community and the Peonle's Penublic of China on trade in textile products, initialled no Pecember 1998 and put intc nrovisional application as from 1 January 1989 . in order to examine the Chinese renuest for an adjustment of the quantitative limits on certain oroducts affected by the implementation of the Harmonized System.
2. As a result of the above consultations, the two Parties agreed to amend the duantitative limits set out in Annex III of the Agreement with regard to catecories $4,5,6,7,8,16,21,27,73$ and categories 10 and 67 . The new quantitative limits for 1990 and the resulting limits for the years 1991 and 1992 are set out in Annex A to the present Agreed Minute.
3. The new allocation of the above quantitative limits among the reaions of the Community for the vear 1990 is indicated in Annex $B$ to the present Agreed linute.
4. The two Jarties anreed that the special orovisions of classification of nroducts affected hy the introduction of the Harmonized System of Nomenclature (nrovisions "box 9") anreed unon throunh exchanaes of Votes Verbales (Note Vorhale of the Chinese Hissinn, SF $V^{\bullet} 33 / 88$, dated 16.03 .1988 ; Note Verbale of the Sommunitv, $N^{\circ} 442 \pi$, तated 14.4 .1988 ; Note Verbale of the Chinese l!ission. SF $\cup^{\circ} 51 / 48$, nf 16.06 .1988 ; Vote Verbale of the Community, N. 10339, of 26.07.1088: "ote Verhale of the Chinese Mission, SF $V^{\circ} 62 / 88$, of 30.08.1988: $\operatorname{lote}$ lerhale of the Community, $v^{\circ}$ 003204, of 15.02.1999), will no more be annlied to goods shioped from China after the 3 lst of December 1989.
5. The twn Parties further agreed that, without prejudice to the Agreed Minute $V^{\bullet} 7$ of the Aṇreement on trade in textile products, the adjustments of the quantitative limits referred to in paragraph 2 above settle the questions of comnensation tue to the introduction of the Harmonized System.
