The restraints were extended pursuant to paragraph 8 of the 1986 Protocol of Extension. Market statements on these extensions are attached.

Dear Ambassador Rafaelli:

This will confirm my earlier oral notifications that:

- (a) the United States had earlier this month requested Thailand to agree, pursuant to paragraph 8 of Article 3, to a one year extension of restraints for four categories: 314, 614, 336/636 and 647/648; and
- (b) in the absence of a response from Thailand, the United States had invoked the provisions of paragraph 8 of the protocol of extension to extend for one year at 6% growth the restraints on three of the four categories: 614, 336/636, and 647/648. The new restraints will be effective as from October 30, 1990 for category 614 and October 31, 1990 for categories 336/636 and 647/648.

A copy of the diplomatic note, and supporting data, which was provided to the government of Thailand on October 26, is enclosed.

THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE PRESENTS ITS COMPLIMENTS TO THE EMBASSY OF THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND AND REFERS TO THE ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES, WITH ANNEXES, DONE AT BENEVA ON DECEMBER 22, 1973 (THE ARRANGEMENT) AND TO THE PROTOCOL OF EXTENSION DATED JULY 31, 1986 (THE PROTOCOL). THE DEPARTMENT FURTHER REFERS TO THE U.S. FMBASSY IN BANGKOK'S NOTE OF OCTOBER 15, 1992 REGARDING RENEWAL OF THE RESTRAINTS ON CATEGORIES 314 AND 614. WHICH ARE SCHEDULED TO EXPIRE ON OCTOBER 29, 1992. AND ON CATEGORIES 336/636 AND 647/648, WHICH ARE SCHEDULED TO FXPIRE ON OCTOBER 30, 1992.

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES NOTES THAT THE GOVERNMENT OF THAILAND HAD ACCEPTED THE EXISTING RESTRAINTS ON CATEGORIFS 314, 614 AND 647/643.

IN LIGHT OF CURRENT MARKET CONDITIONS, THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 3, PARAGRAPH 9 OF THE ARRANGEMENT, PARAGRAPHS 3 AND 5 OF ANNEX B OF THE ARRANGEMENT AND PARAGRAPH 3 OF THE PROTOCOL, IS EXTENDING WITH SIX PERCENT GROWTH THE RESTRAINT LEVELS FOR CATEGORIES 514, 336/635 AND 547/645 FOR AN ADDITIONAL TWELVE MONTHS AT THE LEVELS PROPOSED IN THE NOTE OF OCTOBER 15, 1990.

A REQUEST FOR CONSULTATIONS WAS MADE ON THAILAND (CATEGORY 547/648) IN OCTOBER 1939. FOLLOWING CONSULTATIONS, THE ROYAL THAI GOVERNMENT ACCEPTED A RESTRAINT LEVEL OF 542,763 DOZEN FOR THE PFRIOD OCTOBER 31, 1989 THROUGH OCTOBER 37, 1997. BASED ON DATE OF IMPORT DATA, U.S. MAN-MADE FIBER TROUSFR, SLACK AND SHORT IMPORTS (CATEGORY 647/648) FROM THAILAND REACHED 721,258 DOZEN DURING THE YEAR ENDING AUGUST 1989 LEVEL AND 33 PERCENT ABOVE THE 12

MONTH RESTRAINT LEVEL. WITHOUT A RESTRAINT IN PLACE, THE SHARP AND SUBSTANTIAL INCREASE IN IMPORTS OF MAN-MADE FIBER TROUSERS, SLACKS AND SHORTS (CATEGORY 547/548) FROM THAILAND WOULD CONTINUE.

THE U.S. MARKET FOR MAN-MADE FIBER TROUSERS, SLACKS AND SHORTS (CATEGORY 647/648) HAS BEEN DISRUPTED BY IMPORES. THE REMOVAL OF THE RESTRAINT COUPLED WITH THE IMMINENT AND MEASURABLE INCREASE IN IMPORTS OF MAN-MADE FIBER TROUSERS, SLACKS AND SHORTS FROM THAILAND WOULD EXACERBATE THE MARKET DISRUPTION AND FURTHER IMPEDE THE STEADY AND ORDERLY DEVELOPMENT OF TRADE.

U.S. PRODUCTION AND MARKET SHARE

U.S. PRODUCTION OF MAN-MADE FIBER TROUSERS, SLACKS AND SHORTS (CATEGORY 647/648) FELL FROM 41,442 THOUSAND DOZEN IN 1937 TO 37,627 THOUSAND DOZEN IN 1989, A DECLINE OF 9 PERCENT. THE DOMESTIC MANUFACTURERS' SHARE OF THE MAN-MADE FIBER TROUSER, SLACK AND SHORT MARKET DECLINED FROM 65 PERCENT IN 1987 TO 61 PERCENT IN 1939.

U.S. IMPORTS AND IMPORT PENETRATION

U.S. IMPORTS OF MAN-MADE FIBER TROUSERS, SLACKS AND SHORIS (CATEGORY 647/648) INCREASED 11 PERCENT BETWEEN 1937 AND 1939, REACHING 24.222 THOUSAND DOZEN. DURING THE YEAR ENDING AUGUST 1990, IMPORTS OF CATEGORY 647/648 INCREASED 9 PERCENT, TO 25,293 THOUSAND DOZEN, WHEN COMPARED TO THE SAME PERIOD IN 1989. THE RATIO OF IMPORTS TO DOMESTIC PRODUCTION REACHED 64 PERCENT IN 1939, UP 11 PERCENTAGE FOINTS FROM 53 PERCENT IN 1937.

VCISULONCO DHA NCITAUTIZ TROPMI

A REQUEST FOR CONSULTATIONS WAS MADE ON THAILAND (CATEGORY 336/636) IN OCTOBER 1939. FOLLOWING A FAILURE TO REACH A MEGOTIATED SOLUTION TO THIS MATIER, A RESTRAINT LEVEL OF 93,787 DOZEN WAS IMPOSED FOR THE PERIOD OCTOBER 31, 1989 THROUGH OCTOBER 30, 1990. BASED ON DATE OF IMPORT DATA, U.S. COTTON AND MAN-MADE FIBER DRESS IMPORTS (CATEGORY 336/636) FROM THAILAND REACHED 146,889 DOZEN DURING THE YEAR ENDING AUGUST 1990, 77 PERCENT ABOVE THE YEAR ENDING AUGUST 1989 LEVEL AND 57 PERCENT ABOVE THE 12 MONTH RESTRAINT LEVEL. WITHOUT A RESTRAINT IN PLACE, THE SHARP AND SUBSTANTIAL INCREASE IN IMPORTS OF COTTON AND MAN-MADE FIBER DRESSES (CATEGORY 336/636) FROM THAILAND WOULD CONTINUE.

THE U.S. MARKET FOR COITON AND MAN-MADE FIBER DRESSES (CATEGORY 336/536) HAS BEEN DISRUPTED BY IMPORTS. THE REMOVAL OF THE RESTRAINT COUPLED WITH THE IMMINENT AND MEASURABLE INCREASE OF COITON AND MAN-MADE FIBER DRESSES FROM THAILAND WOULD EXACERBATE THE MARKET DISRUPTION AND FURTHER IMPEDE THE STEADY AND ORDERLY DEVELOPMENT OF TRADE.

U.S. PRODUCTION AND MARKET SHARE

U.S. PRODUCTION OF COTTON AND MAN-MADE FIBER DRESSES (CATEGORY 336/536) FELL FROM 17.838 THOUSAND DOZEN IN 1987 TO 15.288 THOUSAND DOZEN IN 1989. A DECLINE OF 14 PERCENT. THE DOMESTIC MANUFACTURERS' SHARE OF THE COTTON AND MAN-MADE FIBER DRESS MARKET DECLINED FROM 77 PERCENT IN 1987 TO 72 PERCENT IN 1989.

U.S. IMPORIS AND IMPORT PENETRATION

U.S. IMPORTS OF COTTON AND MAN-MADE FIBER DRESSES (CATEGORY 336/636) INCREASED 12 PERCENT BETWEEN 1937 AND 1939, REACHING 5,853 THOUSAND DOZEN. DURING THE YEAR ENDING AUGUST 1990, IMPORTS OF CATEGORY 336/636 INCREASED 5 PERCENT, TO 5,019 THOUSAND DOZEN, WHEN COMPARED TO THE SAME PERIOD IN 1939. THE RATIO OF IMPORTS TO DOMESTIC PRODUCTION REACHED 39 PERCENT IN 1939, UP 9 PERCENTAGE POINTS FROM 29 PERCENT IN 1937.

IMPORT SITUATION AND CONCLUSION

A REQUEST FOR CONSULTATIONS WAS MADE ON THAILAND (CATEGORY 614) IN OCTOBER OF 1989. FOLLOWING CONSULTATIONS, THE ROYAL THAI GOVERNMENT ACCEPTED A

RESTRAINT LEVEL OF 12,725,283 SQUARE METERS FOR THE PERIOD OCTOBER 3M, 1989 THROUGH OCTOBER 29, 1990. BASED ON DATE OF IMPORT DATA, U.S. MAN-MADE FIBER POPLIN AND BROADCLOTH FABRIC IMPORTS (CATEGORY 614) FROM THAILAND REACHED 12,892,885 SQUARE METERS DURING THE YEAR ENDING AUGUST 1990. 5 PERCENT ABOVE THE YEAR ENDING AUGUST 1989 LEVEL AND 7 PERCENT ABOVE THE 12 MONTH RESTRAINT LEVEL. WITHOUT A RESTRAINT IN PLACE, THE INCREASE IN IMPORTS OF MAN-MADE FIBER POPLIN AND BROADCLOTH FABRIC (CATEGORY 614) FROM THAILAND WOULD CONTINUE.

THE U.S. MARKET FOR MAN-MADE FIBER POPLIN AND BROADCLOTH FABRIC (CATEGORY 614) HAS BEEN DISRUPTED BY IMPORTS. THE REMOVAL OF THE RESTRAINT COUPLED WITH THE IMMINENT AND MEASURABLE INCREASE OF MAN-MADE FIBER POPLIN AND BROADCLOTH IMPORTS FROM THAILAND WOULD EXACERBATE THE MARKET DISRUPTION AND FURTHER IMPEDE THE STEADY AND ORDERLY DEVELOPMENT OF TRADE.

U.S. PRODUCTION AND MARKET SHARF

U.S. PRODUCTION OF MAN-MADE FIBER FO LIN AND BROADCLOTH FABRIC FELL TO 598,573,020 SQUARE METERS IN 1989, 2.4 PERCENT BELOW THE 1988 LEVEL AND 24 PERCENT BELOW THE 1987 LEVEL. PROPUCTION CONTINUED DOWNWARD IN 1992, FALLING TO 567,549,272 SQUARE METERS IN THE YEAR ENDING MARCH 1989 LEVEL.

THE DOMYSTIC PRODUCTRS' SHARE OF THE MAN-MADE FIBER POPLIN AND BROADCLOTH FABRIC MARKET DROPPED FROM AN AVERAGE 95 PERCENT IN 1985 - 1988 TO 91 PERCENT IN 1989 AND 97 FERCENT IN THE YEAR ENDING MARCH 1997.

U.S. IMPORTS AND IMPORT PENETRATION

U.S. IMPORTS OF MAN-MADE FIBER POPLIN AND BROADCLOTH FABRIC INCREASED 91 PERCENT IN 1989 OVER 1986, REACHING 51,578,828 SOUARE METERS. CATEGORY 614 IMPORTS INCREASED 4 PERCENT IN THE YEAR ENDING AUGUST 1990 OVER THE YEAR ENDING AUGUST 1990 OVER THE YEAR ENDING AUGUST 1990 LEVEL. THE RATIO OF IMPORTS TO DOMESTIC PRODUCTION REACHED 10 PERCENT IN 1989, NEARLY DOUBLE THE 1986 - 1989 AVERAGE LEVEL. THE RATIO INCREASED TO 11 PERCENT IN THE YEAR ENDING MARCH 1992.

DUTY-PAID VALUE AND U.S. PRODUCERS' PRICE
